

## Agreement and Declaration

relating to

Access to Allithwaite Church of England Controlled School through the grounds of St Mary's Church, Allithwaite, Grange-over-Sands, Cumbria.

**THIS AGREEMENT AND DECLARATION** is made .....<sup>26<sup>th</sup></sup> day of August..... Two thousand and eleven

Between:

1. The Team Rector of the Cartmel Peninsula Team Ministry in the Diocese of Carlisle in the County of Cumbria ("the Team Rector");
2. The Parochial Church Council of the Parish of Allithwaite ("the PCC"); and
3. The Governors of the Allithwaite Church of England Controlled School ("the Governors").

We, the above parties to this agreement, commit to work in the spirit of co-operation, understanding and trust for the mutual benefit of both Church and School needs and with this in mind:

I. The Team Rector and the PCC grant to the Governors

- Permission to access the school via the church drive (except when it is necessary for the PCC to close the drive for legal, health, safety, operational or security reasons), such consent not to be unreasonably withheld, and
- To make reasonable use of the car park facilities.


II. The Governors undertake to


- Share the cost with the PCC of maintaining the drive, access roadway, paths and car park areas and
- Share the cost of any necessary signage, lighting, security, health and safety measures or any other action, thing or measure appropriate or requisite.

III. The PCC and the Governors will each be responsible as appropriate for health, safety and security in the use of contractors or other persons and will bear their own share of any costs associated with such work.

IV. Any party to this agreement may terminate it by giving 12 months notice to each of the other parties.
